This year we are concentrating on developing judicial education material on two topics – human trafficking and the rise of animal rights in court litigation. Our last newsletter discusses these topics in more detail.

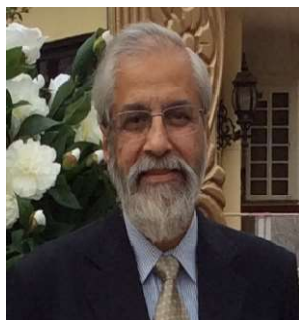
